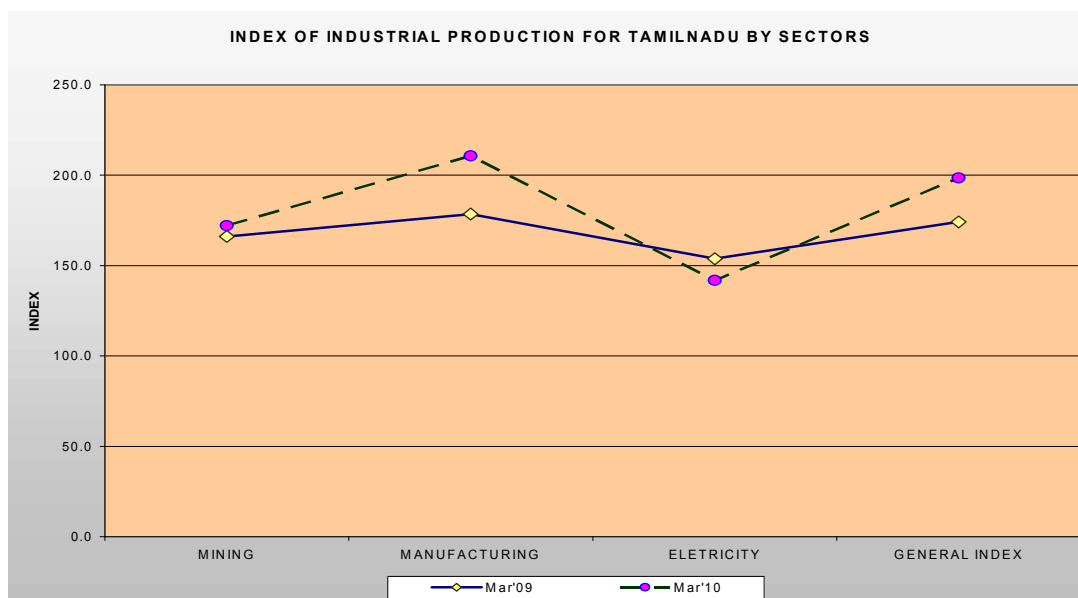

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## **TREND IN THE INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION IN TAMIL NADU**

**Month: March 2010 (Revised)**

***(Base : 1999-2000=100)***

### **1.GENERAL TREND:**

Tamil Nadu is the one and only state compiling Monthly Index of Industrial Production with Base year 1999-2000, where as All India Index of Industrial Production is compiled with Base year 1993-94. The trends noticed in this State Index of Industrial Production as well as in All India Index of Industrial Production are positive.

Industrial production grew by an impressive growth of 13.9% in March 2010 as compared to a slippage of 1.7% witnessed in March 2009. This is the sixth consecutive month the industrial output has posted a double digit growth. The overall industrial growth of Tamil Nadu during March'10 increased by 4.4% when compared with the previous month of the current year. The General index stood at 198.5 in March 2010 as against 174.2 in the same period of last year (Table II). Analysts expect the factory output to ease a little more in the coming months due to the twin impact of withdrawal of stimulus and uncertainty about the global economic recovery (Table II).

Industrial sector witnessed a growth of 9.6% as compared to just 1.7% in the last year (Table IV). The state growth rate in the second half yearly of this financial year is 13.3% higher when compared with the first half yearly average growth is 5.9% at the respective year. This trend reflects good atmosphere of fast industrial growth in state economy. While comparing the Quick Estimates of Index of Industrial Production [with base year 1993-94] released by CSO, New Delhi for All India for the month of March 2010, the General Index stood at 347.3, which is 13.5% higher as compared to the

level in the month of March 2009. The cumulative growth for the period 2009-10 (Apr-Mar) stands at 10.4% over the corresponding period of the previous year.

## **2. SECTORAL TREND:**

The Manufacturing sector witnessed a higher growth while Mining and Electricity sectors shows a declining trend during the month under review as compared to March 2009. The Indices of Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity sectors during the month of March'10 stood at 172.1, 210.6 and 141.7 respectively. During the month of March'10 the growth in Mining and Manufacturing sectors grew by 3.6% and 18.0% respectively where as Electricity sector went down by 7.9% when compared with the same month a year ago. During March 2010 the growth in all the three sectors viz. Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity accelerated by 8.0%, 3.9% and 7.3% respectively when compared to the previous month of the current year (Table II).

For All India, the indices of Industrial Production for Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity sectors for the month of March 2010 stood at 232.8, 373.6 and 260.0 respectively with the corresponding growth rates of 11.0%, 14.3% and 7.7% as compared to March 2009.

The Cumulative Indices of Manufacturing and Electricity have recorded a positive growth of 11.2% and 1.1% respectively while the Mining sector recorded a negative growth of 0.3% during the period of 2009-10(Apr-Mar) when compared the indices of the same period of last year (Table V). For All India, the cumulative growth during April-March (2009-10) over the corresponding period of 2008-09 in three sectors have been 9.7%, 10.9% and 6.0% respectively.

## **MINING SECTOR:**

During March 2010, the Index of Mining sector stood at 172.1 registering a growth of 3.6% and 18.0% when compared to the corresponding month of previous year and the previous month of current year. (Table II)

### **2.1 MANUFACTURING SECTOR:**

During March'10, the Index of Manufacturing sector which constitutes 81% of Tamil Nadu's Industrial Production stood at 210.6 registering a positive growth of 18.0% over the corresponding month of the previous year.

In Manufacturing sector, 16 out of 22 subgroups (at 2 digit level) have shown a positive growth during the month of March 2010 and the other 5 subgroups registered a negative growth when compared with March 2009. The subgroup Manufacture of Office Accounting and Computing Machinery having only item viz. Computer for which the only one factory selected has reported nil production during March 2010. Hence the index of the above subgroup during March 2010 is not available. Machinery and Equipment N.E.C subgroup has recorded the highest positive growth of 50.2% followed by Publishing, Printing and Reproduction of Recorded Media subgroup with 40.0% and Medical Precision and Optical Instruments, Watches and Clocks subgroup with 38.9%. On the other hand Manufacture of Furniture, Manufacturing N.E.C subgroup recorded a negative growth of 37.1% followed by Coke, Refined Petroleum Products and Nuclear Fuel sub group with 25.0% and Radio, Television and Communication Equipment and Apparatus subgroup with 11.0% (Table III).

While comparing the All India Manufacturing sector, 14 out of 17 subgroups (at 2 digit level) have shown a positive growth during the month of March'10 and the other 3 subgroup registered a negative growth when compared with March 2009.

**1. Code 15: Manufacture of Food Products and Beverages (Weight 75.97):**

The index of this group increased to 146.6 during March 2010 from 123.5 during March'09 there by registering a positive growth of 18.7%. This was mainly due to the increase in production of Oil, Sunflower, Ghee, Milk, Skimmed or Pasteurized, Non-Flavoured, Rice, Par-Boiled, Wheat Flour (Atta), Maida, Tea (Black)Leaf (Unblended), Tea (Black)Dust (Blended), Tea (Black)Dust (Unblended) and Spices Mixed. (Table III)

**2. Code 18: Manufacture of Wearing Apparel, Dressing and Dying of Fur (Weight 32.26):**

Under this group inspite of the increase in the production of Garments Leather, the fall in the production of Trousers / Pants, Cotton, Shirts / Bush shirts, Cotton and Gloves Leather lowered the group index by 4.0% during March 2010 as compared to March 2009. (Table III)

**3. Code 23: Manufacture of Coke, Refined Petroleum Products and Nuclear Fuel (Weight 18.77):**

The index relates to this group decreased to 108.4 during March'10 from 144.6 during March 2009 there by registering a negative growth of 25.0%. This was mainly due to the fall in production of Asphalt, Natural, Fuel Aviation Turbine, Petrol (Motor Spirit), Diesel, High Speed and Furnace Oil. (Table III)

**4. Code 32: Manufacture of Radio, Television and Communication Equipment and Apparatus (Weight 7.45):**

The index of this group which was 192.2 during March 2009 declined to 171.1 during March 2010 registering a negative growth of 11.0%. This was mainly due to the low production of Parts, Switch Gears & Control Gears and Hearing Aids. (Table III)

**5. Code 36: Manufacture of Furniture, Manufacturing N.E.C. (Weight 4.77):**

The index of this group which was 89.2 during March 2009 declined to 56.1 during March 2010 registering a negative growth of 37.1%. This was mainly due to the low production of Mattresses, Foam and Rubber, Cabinet, Iron/Steel, Guitar, Zip Fastener (Zipper) and Flowers, Artificial- Decorative (Table III)

The Index of Manufacturing sector during the period 2009-10 (Apr-Mar) stood at 191.5 as against 172.2 in the corresponding period of previous year i.e., 2008-09 (Apr-Mar) registering a positive growth of 11.2%.(Table IV)

While comparing the cumulative Indices of 2009-10 (Apr-Mar) with that of 2008-09 (Apr-Mar) it is noticed that 14 subgroups out of 22 subgroups under Manufacturing sector registered a positive growth, the other 7 subgroups recorded a negative growth and Manufacture of Furniture, Manufacturing N.E.C subgroup only remained static. Publishing Printing and Reproduction of Recorded Media n.e.c. subgroup has recorded the highest positive growth of 31.5 % followed by Machinery and Equipment N.E.C. subgroup with 20.9 % and Tanning and Dressing of Leather, Manufacture of Luggage, Handbags Saddlery, Harness and Footwear subgroup with 18.2%. On the other hand Wearing Apparel, Dressing and

Dyeing of Fur subgroup recorded a negative growth of 11.8% followed by Radio, Television and Communication Equipment and Apparatus sub group with 7.8 % and Tobacco Products subgroup with 4.4% (Table V). While comparing the All India cumulative Indices of 2009-10 (Apr-Mar) with that of 2008-09 (Apr-Mar) it is noticed that 15 subgroups out of 17 subgroups under Manufacturing sector registered a positive growth and the other 2 subgroups registered a negative growth.

## **2.2 ELECTRICITY SECTOR:**

During March'10, the Index of Electricity sector stood at 141.7 registering a growth of -7.9% and 7.3% as compared with the corresponding month of the previous year and previous month. (Table II)

## **USE - BASED CLASSIFICATION:**

The Capital Goods has shown a considerable increase to the extent of 35.6% in March 2010 when compared with previous year. The growth in Intermediate Goods comprising components of Key Ingredients of Manufactured Products accelerated by 10.5% during March'10 when compared with the same month a year ago. The growth in Basic goods decelerated by 2.8% during March 2010 as compared to March 2009. With in the Consumer Goods which show a positive growth of 8.9%, Durable and Non-durable goods accelerated by 7.1% and 9.4% respectively (Table VI). While comparing the All India as per Use-based Classification in March 2010 over March 2009 the Basic Goods, Capital Goods and Intermediate Goods grew by 10.1%, 27.4% and 12.7% respectively. With in the Consumer Goods segment, which has shown a positive growth of 10.6%, Durables and Non Durables posted a growth of 32.0% and 3.3% respectively.

While comparing the cumulative indices as per Use-based classification during the period 2009-10(Apr-Mar) with the respective indices of same period of previous year, high growth (18.1%) in Capital Goods sector is a sign of turn around in the economy and the positive trend in industrial output will continue, as Capital Goods are mainly Machinery and Equipments that are installed by manufacturing units for expansion of production capacities. Basic Goods and Intermediate Goods rose by 5.8% and 7.5% respectively during 2009-10(Apr-Mar) when compared to 2008-09 (Apr-Mar). The Consumer Goods also grew by 4.8% in which Consumer Durable and Consumer Non-Durable Goods showed a positive growth of 0.3% and 5.6% respectively (Table VII). For All India cumulative indices as per Use-based classification during the period 2009-10 (Apr-Mar) with the respective indices of same period of previous year, the growth was 7.1% in Basic Goods, 19.2% in Capital Goods, 13.6 % in Intermediate Goods and 7.4 % in Consumer Goods in which Consumer Durable Goods and Consumer Non-Durable Goods exhibited a growth of 26.1% and 1.5% respectively.

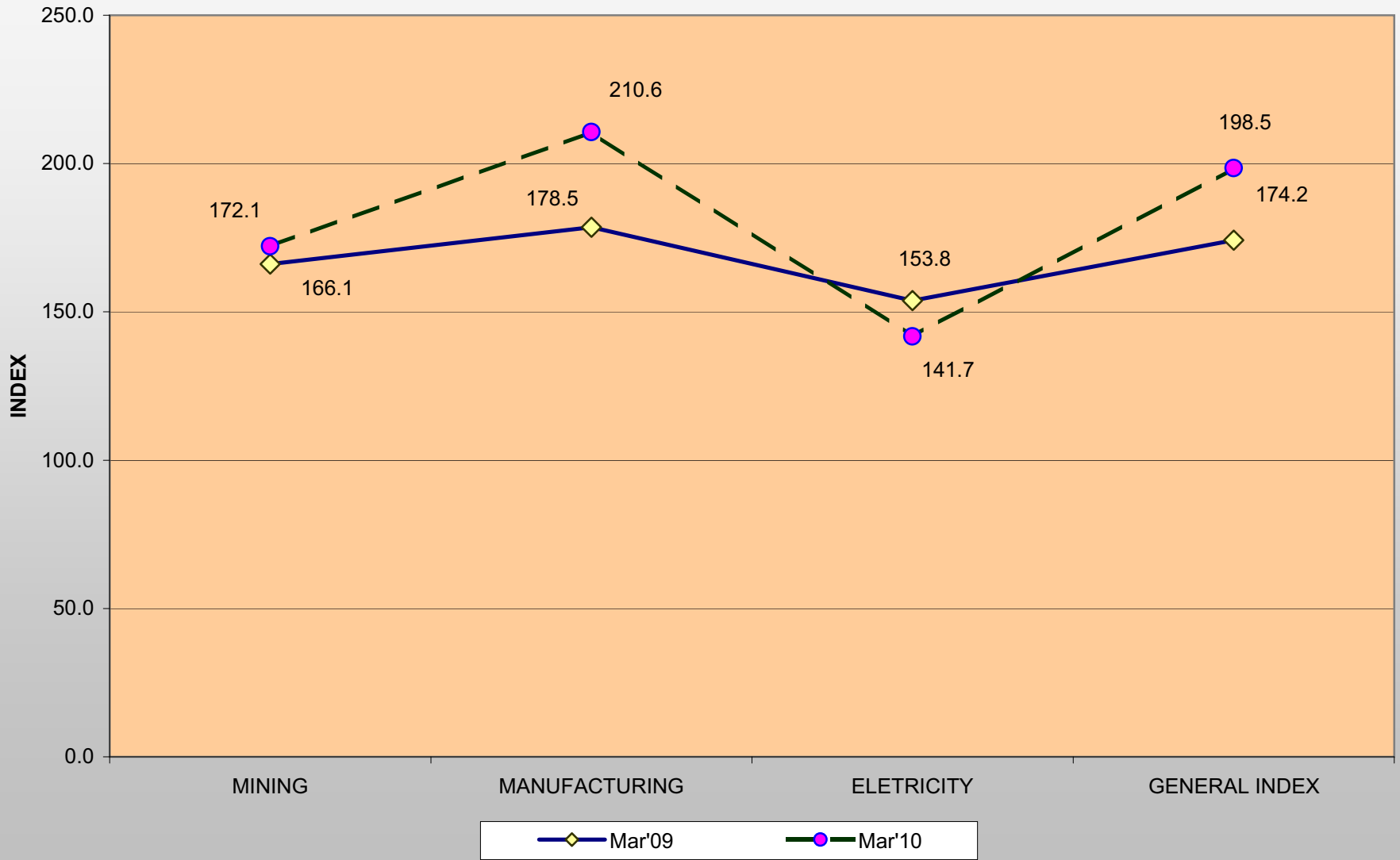
